L. D. BRITT SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarship Guidelines

The Union District Congress of Christian Education will award three scholarships annually to worthy young men and women who are currently graduating seniors at its annual session, who have not previously won any monetary grant award from the Union District Congress of Christian Education.

The following requirements must be met for all participants:

- A. Must be a member in good and regular standing of a Baptist Church That represents annually in the March Conference. Church needs to be registered with the District with \$10.00 Monthly or \$120.00/Annually to the Scholarship Fund. Graduating senior must be active participates in the institute during the year.
- B. Must provide a written letter of recommendation from his or her Pastor or person or persons authorized by his or her local church if church is without a Pastor.
- C. Must submit a written essay based upon the current theme of the Union District Congress of Christian Education.
- D. Must be in attendance at the annual session in which awards shall be given unless in case of an emergency such as sickness, death or extenuating circumstances that could prevent the participant's attendance at the conference. (In case of an emergency which would prevent an award winner from being present, the winner must contact the 2nd Vice President, Dean or the Associate Dean)

ACADEMIC

- A. Must be a graduating senior in the class of 2025
- B. Must provide high school transcript, Application for admission and proof of acceptance to an institution of higher education.

JUDGING AND AWARDING OF SCHOLARSHIPS

- A. The essay must be typed.
- B. The essay will be submitted to the standing scholarship committee which will judge each essay on the following: Composition, Clarity, Content, Sentence Structure, Grammar, and Punctuation,
- C. In case of a tie, the scholarship will be awarded based upon an oral Presentation of the essay before the scholarship committee or those appointed by the President of the Union District Congress of Christian Education at the annual session.
- D. All scholarships will be presented to the winners at the annual session.
- E. The Conference reserves the right to deny awarding any or all Scholarships if all requirements are not met.
